GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- Contractor shall stay 10 feet from all city utilities.
- Adequate provisions shall be made for protection of the highway traffic at all times. Necessary detours, barricades, warning signs and flagmen shall be provided by and at the expense of the applicant and shall be in accordance with the current edition of the Federal Highway Administration’s Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The work shall be planned and carried out so that there will be the least possible inconvenience to the highway traffic. The applicant agrees to observe all rules and regulations of the City while carrying on the work contemplated herein and take all other precautions that circumstances warrant.
- The applicant shall be responsible for obtaining any other approvals or permits necessary for construction.
- It is of the utmost importance that all contractors utilize the “Call Before You Dig” law.
